CORPORATE IDENTITY GUIDELINES

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INTRODUCTION

This document describes the TELETASK Corporate Identity details. A uniform corporate identity is a valuable commercial asset. Effective use of our logo and name is an important representation of the TELETASK identity. These guidelines have been designed to introduce the TELETASK corporate identity and to help everyone use it correctly.

The consistent and effective use of our identity is important. These rules apply across all media, and should be used for both internal and external applications.

BRAND NAME OWNERSHIP

The TELETASK brand name is registered and owned by TELETASK BVBA. No other parties are allowed to use the brand name except by written agreement of TELETASK BVBA.

COMPANY NAME

First of all, the TELETASK Brand name should always be used without any accompanying words. The only addition to the brand name can be the slogan: "Trendsetter in Home Automation" or "Trendsetter in Domotics" (Countries where the word 'Domotics' is used).

Secondly, the **TELETASK brand name should always be written in CAPITAL letters** (also all product names, such as 'AURUS-2').

As several third party products are called 'Home Automation' and 'domotics' but can hardly be called like that, we can also use as a subtitle to the TELETASK company name the words: "Integrated solutions" or "integrated systems". But this is only to be used for professional applications (end-users are not supposed to understand what 'integrated solutions' stands for).



OUR VALUES

The TELETASK style is built around the TELETASK core values:

- Quality: materials, finishing, durability, continuity
- **Exclusivity**: design, timeless and yet contemporary, discreet
- **Luxury**: a TELETASK installation must feel as an upgrade and increases the comfort
- **Simplicity**: simple to configure and easy to use
- Environment: respect for nature, constantly improving our software to increase building energy efficiency to fight global warming

It's our intention to keep this up to date with all new TELETASK products. You can use this link without logging in so there's no need to create a Dropbox account.

TELETASK BVBA has the ownership of the shared files. TELETASK distributers can use these files for all TELETASK marketing actions and publications. These should never be used for other purposes.

FILE TYPES

There are several file types available. Each file type has its specific use. The pictures have a description in there filename to define there purpose.

Always refer to the below list to determine which file to use:

xx_LowRes.jpg

Most xx_LowRes images have a max. resolution of 1280px width or height (depending of their orientation). This resolution is more than sufficient for digital use (websites, PowerPoints, social media, ...).

xx LowRes-Trans.png

Same as the xx_LowRes.jpg but with a transparent background.

xx_HighRes-CMYK.tif

Only to be used for printed applications. These files have a CMYK colour profile and have a DPI of 300 which is used by professional printing machinery. Don't use these for digital media as it will mess up the colours.

xx_HighRes-CMYK-Trans.tif

Same as the xx_HighRes-CMYK.tif but with a transparent background. Note that not all program's support transparency in .tif.

xx HighRes.tif

Can be used as a source image to crop at a specific size. Be aware that the file size of a .tif is very high, compared with .jpg and .png. So don't use these directly. Convert them to a .jpg or .png. These files are in a RGB colour profile and have a DPI of 300. So these are also not suitable for printed applications!

xx_HighRes-Trans.tif

Same as the xx_HighRes.tif but with a transparent background. Note that not all program's support transparency in .tif.



TELETASK LOGO

There are 4 possible combinations of the TELETASK logo.

Colours:

- white on grey background
- grey on white (or transparent) background

Layout:

- horizontal
- vertical

We recommend to use the white logo on grey background. This gives the logo more body which makes it more prominent. But in case of a dark background or if it is more appealing, you can use the grey on white (or transparent) logo.

FILE TYPES

The TELETASK Logo should always be used as an image, never to be made manually. There are several file types available. Each file type has its specific use. Always refer to the below list to determine which file type to use:

vmf Use in MICROSOFT programs

(MS Word, Powerpoint, Excell).

pg Only to be used on websites or digital media.

use if a transparent background of the logo is necessary.

eps Only to be used in printed media where a large resolution is required.

TYPOGRAPHY

Our primary typeface for web and print materials is Segoe UI. We use the Regular weight in a dark grey colour (K=70%) for a soft appearance.

As titles we primary use Adobe Garamond Pro in all caps. The font weight is Bold and the colour is light brown (C26 M26 Y29 K13).

Please use these as a guide.
